

Road Sense Financial Prospectus
Public Local Inquiry scheduled for Summer 2008

Road Sense exists to challenge the existing Netherley/Milltimber Brae route for an Aberdeen Bypass proposed by Transport Scotland, and will be pursuing this case vigorously at the forthcoming public enquiry.

Road Sense believes that it has a good chance of success and among its arguments are:-

- The flawed decision making process
- The minimal traffic benefits and the flawed traffic modelling
- The low cost/benefit ratio of the route and minimal impact on Aberdeen's traffic
- The environmental damage, including the Dee Valley Special Area of Conservation
- The underestimated costs
- The noise and pollution damage
- The inadequate mitigation measures that have been suggested

If the case against the road is successful, and the independent Inquiry Reporter finds against the proposed alignment of the AWPR, Alex Salmond the First Minister has said that he will base any final decision on the findings of the public enquiry. Road Sense is therefore determined to present the best possible case at the inquiry.
